Côntrole d'accès au domaine CERN (C. Jacot)

Discussion:

Visitors at CERN will not have permanent access to CERN. Only enterprise personnel who come for professional reasons more than once may have access permission for a longer period.

The implementation of a coherent system and the necessary financial means are granted by the CERN management. The rentability of the new guardians contract is not yet known. A first indicator of its rentability is, that no thefts are reported during the Christmas holidays.

The aim of access control is not to bother persons, but to offer a professional service which follows the rules and regulations of the Operation Circular No.2. Information about the progress in the projects will be given via the weekly bulletin and the WWW.

Côntrole d'accès LHC (E. Cennini)

If an enterprise works careless and causes an accident, the CERN personnel may be also responsible. All divisions are responsible for the work they demand.

Real fake alarms are very rare at CERN, nevertheless a lot of alarms arrive without a serious cause. E.g. smoke detection which comes from soldering and not from a real fire.
